If you are new to the club you may not know our club raised half the money to stock trout the first year. Since then Jefferson City and MDC jointly pay for the fish. If you have not been out, the trout may be larger than before. There are many 13, 14, 15 Inch fish along with some that are 16+. However I managed to land a 6.5 and an 8 inch rainbow.

The City is considering putting a load of dirt on the dam where the erosion is the worst by the spillway. They may also add fill on the southeast side where erosion is close to the path. We encouraged them to put in a concrete handicapped ramp, but the initial plan is to dump "shot rock" along the dam.
