### Water Quality Monitoring Training:

The Level 2 training includes short educational videos and a macroinvertebrate quiz to complete atyour-pace prior to the classroom portion. In the classroom, water samples will be analyzed by monitors using their program-issued equipment.

PREREQUISITES TO ATTEND LEVEL 2:Completion of VWQM Level 1 and submission of two seasons of data including biological, water chemistry, visual survey, and stream discharge.
