### Fly of the Month

GASTON'S GOODS FOR June

Name: Baetis Midge (Celery color)

Hook: Mustad #94840

Size: 19-20-22

Thread: Monochord 3/0

Color: #70 Danville (Celery)

Tail: White Hackle

Body: Danville #70 Celery Monochord

Hackle: White

1. Ty on white hackle tail. (1/2 length of hook)
2. Build up the body to twice the size of the hook with thread. Body should only be 2/3 the length of the hook.
3. Ty white hackle on the front of the hook using reverse palmer wrapping approximately 3or 4 turns.
4. Whip finish and cement.
