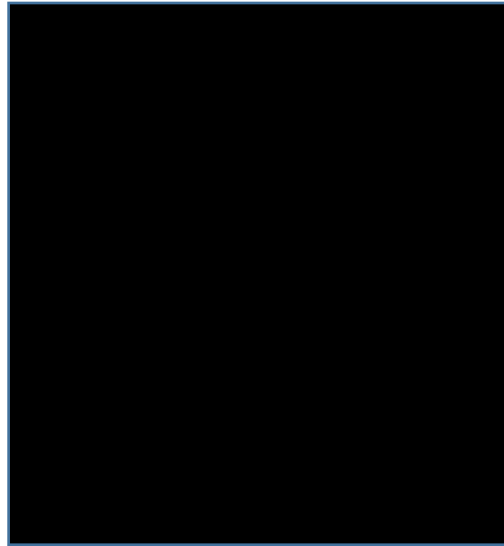

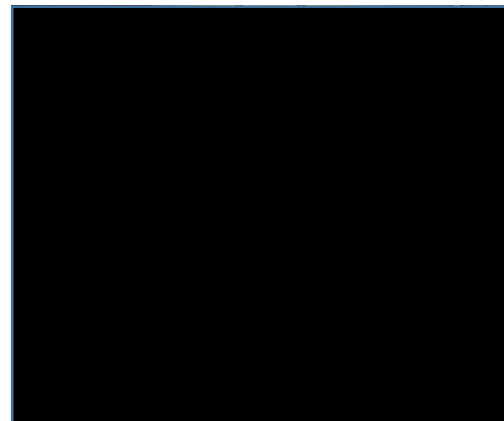
Our VA outing is June 20 at Little Dixie Lake. We will need help to serve food and help with fly fishing.
