Fly of the Month

Recipe for "Copper John"

Material

Hook: Mustad 9672 Size #16

Thread: Black 6/0

Bead: Copper

Tail: Goose biot

Body: Small copper wire (red, green, yellow, blue or copper)

Thorax: Peacock

Shell back: Flashabou

Hackle: Pheasant tail fibers

Steps

1. After you crimp the barb down, place the hook in your vise.
2. Start wrapping the thread at the front of the hook and wrap back to the curve
3. Wrap a small ball at the back of the hook to help separate the tail parts
4. Wrap in the tail biots to form a fork
5. Wrap in the wire and then take the thread 2/3 s of the way up the hook
6. Wrap the wire tightly up the hook of the 2/3s of the way to the eye, tie off with thread and cut off wire.
7. Wrap in the tread over the peacock and flash
8. Wrap the peacock thorax and thread up to the eye
9. Overlay the thorax with the flash and tie off
10. Tie in the pheasant tail hackles and create a head
11. Whip finish and cement the head

This fly is often fished as a dropper below other flies such as hoppers or egg patterns. Have good luck.
