Fly of the Month

"Red Fox Squirrel Hair Nymph"

Recipe:

Hook: Mustad #9671 size 16-20

Thread: Black

Tail: Red-fox squirrel back guard hair & under fur

Rib: Fine oval gold tinsel

Abdomen: Blend 1 part RF Squirrel belly fur and 1 part antron or orlon dubbing of the same color tone

Thorax: RF squirrel back guard hair and under fur

Hackle: Partridge

1. Tie in the tail
2. Tie in the tinsel and dub a tapered body up 2/3 of the shank
3. Wind the tinsel over the abdomen in 5-7 ribs, secure the tinsel and trim
4. Dub a rough, full thorax of guard hair and fur
5. Tie in and add one turn of partridge to the front of the thorax
6. Tie off and trim
