Here is a list of materials that is needed for the next meeting:

**FAVORITE FLY MATERIALS LIST:**

Green Easy...black thread, size 18 dry fly hook, brassie wire-green(other colors work too)!, furnace hackle to match hook size.

Peacock Midge...Olive thread (or iron gray), size 20 or 22 tiemco 101, gray Z-lon, glass or plastic bead to match hook size (peacock bead is preferable)

EZ Bead Head

Pheasant Tail, brown thread, size 14 to 18 tiemco 200R, brass bead to match hook size, pheasant tail fibers, fine gold or copper wire.
